



TU SCHOLARSHIP FOR ASEAN

With the belief in youth powers building ASEAN community, Thammasat University offers scholarship opportunities to prospective students from ASEAN member countries who wish to study MA in ASEAN Studies at Pridi Banomyong International College (PBIC).

Consideration for these scholarships is given to students who are academically competitive, exhibit special talents, and demonstrate strong contributions. Opportunities from Thammasat University not only help seek the advancement of knowledge, but also forge the understanding of differences among member countries. This further brings a caring and sharing society which is inclusive and where the unity among the peoples of ASEAN is enhanced.

I Eligibility Criteria

- Be a national of nine ASEAN member countries including Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore and Vietnam
- 2. Possess a bachelor's degree or its equivalent with at least a 3.0 GPA.
- Meet or exceed the English language proficiency requirements as described in the table below*

Test	Required Score
TU-GET	≥ 500
TOEFL (PBT)	≥ 500
TOEFL (CBT)	≥ 173
TOEFL (IBT)	≥ 61
IELTs (Academic)	≥ 5.0

^{*} The test result must have been awarded no more than two years prior to the deadline of application.

^{*} Native English speakers and candidates whose prior degrees are from a university where the sole language of instruction is English are exempt from this requirement.
